The U.S. Department of Justice <u>indicted Peter Sotis<sup>[1]</sup></u> for alleged violations of the International Emergency Economic Powers Act<sup>[2]</sup> and the Export Administration Regulations.<sup>[3]</sup> Sotis failed to obtain a license for the export of a rebreather (a breathing apparatus that allows divers to stay underwater longer), and exported the equipment through a shipping company to Libya.
