

## Report on Medicare Compliance Volume 31, Number 27. August 01, 2022 Tip Sheet to Help Prevent Inappropriate Orders of Pain Management, DME

Stormont Vail Health in Topeka, Kansas, distributes this tip sheet to physician offices to help patients avoid getting caught up in scams and potentially authorize pharmacies or durable medical equipment (DME) suppliers to ask their physicians to order prescriptions or supplies.
