Following a <u>deadly clash between Indian and Chinese forces</u> along the Himalayan border area, ^[1] India's government decided on June 29 to ban 59 Chinese apps. The Indian Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology issued a <u>news release [2]</u> explaining that the apps were engaged in activities that threatened India's national sovereignty and were therefore banned under Section 69A of the Information Technology Act.
