The May 15 <u>amendments to the foreign-produced direct product rule^[1]</u> isolated Huawei Technologies' supply chain such that the United Kingdom thought it wise to ban the company from its 5G networks. The <u>U.K. had stated in January</u> that Huawei would be isolated from critical infrastructure and networks associated with national security but would still be allowed to sell to noncritical and nonsensitive markets.^[2] The <u>most recent statement^[3]</u> reversed that decision and effectively banned Huawei from the British 5G market July 14.
