A <u>report^[1]</u> released by consulting firm Baker McKenzie in collaboration with Silk Road Associates studied the causes and effects of continued supply chain disruption due to protectionist policies, the COVID-19 pandemic, and trade wars between major world economies. The report found that although companies are considering diversifying operations outside of China, the lure of the world's biggest market, as well as the challenges of restoring complex supply chains, means the predicted dramatic exodus out of China has not materialized.
