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Medicare has precise requirements for billing incident to the physician's services, which allows practices to charge 100% of the physician fee schedule for services performed by nonphysician practitioners (NPPs) instead of 85% when they're billed under the NPPs' national provider identifier. The requirements are summarized in this checklist, which was created by Jean Acevedo, president of Acevedo Consulting in Delray Beach, Florida.
