

## Compliance Today - November 2019 Nonmonetary compensation up to \$416 (CY 2019)

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Compliance officers should review how nonmonetary compensation and benefits are being tracked to confirm the organization is meeting the law's requirements. Pursuant to the Stark Law regulations at 42 C.F.R. § 411.357(k), there are exceptions for nonmonetary compensation. Under the federal Stark Law, hospitals may provide nonmonetary compensation to physicians up to an aggregate amount of \$416 for calendar year 2019.
