

Compliance Today - February 2018 Is it time for an ASP Checkup?

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Most of you will undoubtedly be aware that improper administration of antibiotics is a significant problem that places patients at risk for serious adverse events and contributes to the public health concern of increased antibiotic-resistant infections. Four-year-old data cited by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that more than two million people are infected with antibiotic-resistant organisms, which results in approximately 23,000 deaths annually. Growing evidence that antibiotic stewardship programs reduce these patient risks led the CDC to recommend in 2014 that all acute care hospitals implement such programs.

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
