The United States Department of Justice continued its efforts to combat human trafficking by convening and <u>attending a roundtable^[1]</u> with representatives from Federal Law Enforcement Training Centers to discuss strategies and implement training programs to reduce and eradicate human trafficking. The Department of Justice provided grants totaling more than USD 100 million toward this end, and promised to release more funding during the 2020 fiscal year.
