The Information Commissioner's Office <u>fined DSG Retail Limited (DSG) 500,00 British pounds</u> after an investigation discovered a data breach involving the personal data of approximately 14 million people. Hackers installed malware on 5,390 tills on DSG-run e-commerce platforms, allowing them to siphon the data from July 2017 to April 2018. [1]
