<u>Two Chinese nationals were sanctioned</u><sup>[1]</sup> by the United States Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control for aiding a designated North Korean cybergroup, Lazarus Group, in malicious cybertheft, including the hack of multiple cryptocurrency exchanges. According to a <u>U.S. Department of Justice news</u> release, <sup>[2]</sup> the pair helped launder more than \$100 million worth of cryptocurrency, using hundreds of automated accounts, fake identification information, and doctored photographs to avoid know-your-customer protocols.
