The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative, the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Commerce are taking action after hearings in August that found a possible threat to domestic producers of seasonal fruits and vegetables from Mexican imports. According to a Sept. 1 news release, In more than 60 witnesses testified to the threat of cheap imports, especially following the implementation of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement[2] in July.
