The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative, the Department of Agriculture and the Department of Commerce are taking action after hearings in August that found a possible threat to domestic producers of seasonal fruits and vegetables from Mexican imports. According to a Sept. 1 [news release](#),<sup>[1]</sup> more than 60 witnesses testified to the threat of cheap imports, especially following the implementation of the [United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement](#)<sup>[2]</sup> in July.
